OSBM budget analyses and management services inform the Governor, state agencies and legislature on effective uses of public resources.

House the core national, state, regional, county, and municipal data that their stakeholders rely on.

Improve visual, analytical, planning, and strategic capabilities via a web-based, open data portal.

Improve its workforce information delivery capabilities.

Promote customer service through an improved user experience.

Combine demographic and socioeconomic information in a single portal to provide a complete picture of the North Carolina economy.

THE SOLUTION

OSBM chose Opendatasoft to launch its open data portal, Log Into North Carolina (LINC). The interactive data portal offers:



A SINGLE ACCESS POINT FOR ECONOMIC AND WORKFORCE INFORMATION

The platform gathers more than 900 data items representing the entire state. The data portal serves as the first-best source for North Carolina economic and workforce data.



EASY DATA ACCESS FOR ALL TYPES OF **END USERS**

City management and local entrepreneurs can search, explore, link, download, visualize, and reuse the data for commercial or non-commercial purposes through a catalog of common metadata. This ease of use is a starting point for developing innovative services.



A USER-FRIENDLY OPEN DATA PORTAL

Users can access the data via interactive visualization. On the homepage, a dashboard provides a one-stop view of key topics and figures. Registered users can save visualizations and receive notifications of dataset updates.



Government employees use the portal to make informed decisions with limited resources.





